

SWAN COMBI CHALLENGE

MSVR in conjunction with the FSRA will organise the 2010 Swan Combi Challenge (for F2 Sidecars) which will consist of five events at British Superbike (BSB) meetings. Each meeting will have a have two challenge series races per event.

Scheduled legs not run for any reason will not be awarded points.

At the conclusion of the series all points scored will be added together and the rider/passenger with the highest number of points will be declared the overall winner of the 2010 Swan Combi Challenge.

Jurisdiction.

The Challenge Series will be organised under the MCRCB Sporting Code, General regulations, these series conditions together with any Final Instructions issued for each event and any further official announcements made by MSVR/FSRA.

Eligibility.

1) Riders and Passengers.

All competitors must hold an ACU, SACU or MCUI licence (Novice to International) for Road Racing applicable for the class entered.

2) Machines.

Every motorcycle entered must meet the requirements as stated in ACU Standing Regulations (F2 sidecars).

Registration

Drivers & passengers must be registered for the 2010 ACU British F2 Championship, however places for up to 6 "wild cards" at each event will be reserved for allocation by MSVR/FSRA.

Driver & passenger must become a member of the FSRA

Entry forms must be obtained from and returned directly to Pat Hamblin

Qualifying/Grid positions.

Riders will qualify for grid positions according to their qualifying practice times. At ACU Championship rounds the grid will be the same for both races. At all other events the grid for race two will be the finishing order of race one with the top eight positions reversed.

Podium

At the end of each race the first three finishers must attend the podium ceremony and post race TV interviews.

Fuel

UNLEADED PETROL as defined by the European Committee for Standardization (CEN), EN 228 (1993) or BS EN 228 (British Standards BS7070) must be used for this Championship series.

Machine Verification.

Random verification may take place at any time and will be at the Entrants expense. The time and location will be the decision of the Race Director. Parc Ferme conditions will apply after qualifying and races.

Engine and frame numbers.

All sidecars are required to have engine numbers that have obviously not been tampered with or deleted. The automatic penalty is exclusion of machine.

TV/publicity/programme/website

An area set aside in the programme and BSB official website for up to date news and information, to be supplied to MSVR by FSRA.

The series title shall be: **The Swan Combi Challenge**

No other wording may feature in any bolder print size.

At each Challenge round at least one event will be recorded by the TV outside broadcast production for transmission on the BSB Extras highlights show on British Eurosport 2.

Series decals

All competitors must display the official series decals (supplied by MSVR) at each Challenge event on the top of the front number plate area.
