Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

### **Brief Details:**

Following a review of Livestream & CCTV video, it was found that Car #77 had gone wide at Lodge Corner, allowing Car #55 to come alongside. As the cars went side by side through Deer Leap, there was contact between the two cars, which prevented Car #77 from fully rejoining the track & eventually resulted in both cars spinning at the Pit lane Entrance; Car #55 going over the Pit Lane Entrance barrier. The driver of Car #55 was requested to attend Race Control to discuss the incident, but was reported as having left the circuit. In his absence I judged that he had caused the collisions.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race  
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

You are reminded of your right of appeal. The penalty applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4

The driver/entrant was not present for this decision. Please see Motorsport UK Regulation C 6.3 (f) for details of time limits for appeals.
