Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

### **Brief Details:**

By moving from track right to track left at Turn 2 Car 4 caused a collision with Car 68. The driver of Car 4 admitted that he had not seen Car 68. As a result of the collision Car 68 retired.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race  
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

Additional Comments: The driver of Car 4, Bryce Aron is the holder of an ACCUS licence # D4375-S22 C. The decision was delivered verbally to the competitor at 14:50 and he was reminded that his appeal time was 30 minutes from 14:50
