Team Manager of Xentec Motorsport visited the Clerk of the Course to complain that a number of cars were out of position behind their grid boxes. Live feed reviewed showing that a number of cars were behind their boxes but this was prior to the formation of the grid having been completed, these competitors still had time to adjust their position before the start procedure. The live feed view then switches to a shot facing down the grid from Paddock Hill bend when the Start Lights are turned on, when they go out the view returns to the aerial shot, however by this point the race has started. Onboard cameras will not be able to show how far back a competitor is from their grid box.

Therefore, I feel in can take no action against any competitor for this.
