Following investigation and having heard evidence from the competitor I find that, you are found guilty of contravening Motorsport UK Regulation (s):

**Q12.21.4** Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Following a request from the driver of car 23 (Simon Clark) to review an incident between himself and car 9 I interviewed both drivers and reviewed each of their cars in car photage as well as the circuit CCTV.

It was accepted that contact took place

It was my finding that neither car could be held fully at fault.

The Car behind (Car 9) did hit the other car. My impression from listening to the sound on Car 9 that the driver did briefly lift off albeit too late to avoid the contact.

It was noted that whilst on this occasion no serios incident occurred in another case it could have.

I have therefore given the driver of car 9 a verbal warning about his driving
