Additional Comments: On report of an altercation between drivers of Car 66 and Car 122 in Parc Ferme after Turismo X Championship Race 1, both drivers were requested to see the Clerk of the Course (Ian Denyer). Witnesses were asked to write written statements on what they had seen. This evidence was presented in the hearing and the decision of the Clerk of the Course verbally communicated to both drivers, resulting in the driver of car 66 being disqualified from the meeting and six points endorsed to their race license.
