Following investigation and having heard evidence from the competitor I find that, you are found guilty of contravening Motorsport UK Regulation (s):

C 1.1.5 – Driving in a manner not compatible with general safety

Brief Detail

Heavy contact in the braking zone of Williams with the rear of car 69 causing car 69 to lose control and spin off the circuit, this then caused other cars to change direction suddenly which caused several cars to spin off the circuit. Onboards of car 69 & 2 were reviewed and car 553 had no working SD card – as per championship regulation 2.13.1 a fine of £50.00 to be submitted to the marshal fund
